WRIT DENIED. There is no indication that relator filed a pretrial motion to quash wherein he complained about the failure of the court to properly record the indictment in the court minutes or return the indictment in open court. Therefore, relator waived review of this claim. See **State v. Mack**, 43,206 (La. App. 2d Cir. 4/23/08), 981 So.2d 185, 190-91, writ denied, 2008-1222 (La. 2/20/09), 1 So.3d 491. Furthermore, a defective indictment does not deprive a court of jurisdiction. See **United States v. Cotton**, 535 U.S. 625, 629-31, 122 S.Ct. 1781, 1784-85, 152 L.Ed.2d 860 (2002).
