

WRIT DENIED. The Louisiana Supreme Court set forth the
criteria for the exercise of supervisory jurisdiction by an
appellate court in **Herlitz Const. Co., Inc. v. Hotel Investors
of New Iberia, Inc.**, 396 So.2d 878 (La. 1981). Insofar as the
criteria of Herlitz are not met in this case, this Court
declines to exercise its supervisory jurisdiction.
