He would grant the writ in part and vacate that portion of the December 19, 2014 judgment denying defendant's, Great American Insurance Company, motion for summary judgment as to the claims by plaintiffs, Southgate Residential Towers, LLC and Southgate Penthouses, LLC, seeking insurance coverage for defective flooring and electrical defects and misplaced plumbing corings/penetrations claims. He would find that the flooring, electrical and plumbing corings/penetrations defects asserted by the plaintiffs are not property damage under the terms of the relevant policies; therefore, no coverage exists for said claims. Accordingly, he would dismiss Claims 5 through 9 of the plaintiffs' petition as to the defendant. In all other respects, he concurs in the denial of the writ.
