In Re: Laris Insurance Agency, LLC and Laris Insurance Agency, Inc., applying for supervisory writs, 23rd Judicial District Court, Parish of Ascension, No. 110956.

BEFORE: McDONALD, CRAIN AND HOLDRIDGE, JJ.

WRIT GRANTED. Respondent/plaintiff, Fab-Con, Inc., has not alleged that wrongful conduct on the part of relators/defendants, Laris Insurance Agency, LLC and Laris Insurance Agency, Inc., occurred or that the damages it allegedly sustained arose in Ascension Parish so as to warrant venue there pursuant to La. Code Civ. P. art. 74. Accordingly, the judgment of the trial court signed March 4, 2015 denying the declinatory exception of improper venue filed by Laris Insurance Agency, LLC and Laris Insurance Agency, Inc. is hereby reversed, and the matter is remanded to the trial court for transfer to a court of proper venue or, in the alternative, dismissal in accordance with La. C.C.P. art. 121.
