WRIT GRANTED WITH ORDER. We find the defendant has shown good cause for an independent medical examination. See La. C.C.P. art. 1464. Accordingly, the trial court's February 19, 2015 ruling is reversed, and defendant's Motion to Compel Neuropsychological Testing and Evaluation is granted. The trial court is instructed to order the plaintiff to submit to neuropsychological testing by Dr. Michael Chafetz, which shall be limited to two days with the defendant obligated to pay for the plaintiff's lodging and meals for the stay.
