

WRIT DENIED. Relator seeks review of the district court's judgment dismissing his petition for judicial review. A final judgment of the district court dismissing an appeal of an administrative remedy procedure is an appealable judgment and an aggrieved party may appeal to the appropriate court of appeal. See La. R.S. 15:1177(A)(10). Accordingly, review of the district court's judgment is not proper under this Court's supervisory jurisdiction. However, we note that relator has sought review of the same judgment in an appeal pending in this Court under docket number 2015 CA 1320, lodged on August 27, 2015.
