

WRIT DENIED. The trial court did not err in its June 11, 2015 judgment in dismissing relator's "Application for Writ of Habeas Corpus." Relator is not in detention or confinement as a result of or incidental to the August 15, 2012 arrest warrant, in connection with an alleged violation of La. R.S. 15:542.1.4. Accordingly, relator's Application for Writ of Habeas Corpus fails to advance any valid habeas claim. In order to seek the recall of the August 15, 2012 arrest warrant, relator may file a motion to quash the warrant in the 27th Judicial District Court in St. Landry Parish, where the arrest warrant was issued.
