WRIT NOT CONSIDERED. Relator failed to comply with Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 4-3 and 4-5(C)(11), by failing to include documentation of a timely request for a return date following the August 14, 2014 judgment, and documentation of a timely request for an extension of the return date set by the district court following the January 28, 2015 denial of the motion to reconsider. This application, filed in this Court on March 28, 2015, is untimely. Relator also failed to comply with Rules 4-5(C)(8), (9) and (10), by failing to include a copy of the pleadings upon which the ruling was founded (including a copy of the indictments, the applications for postconviction relief, supporting memoranda, and the motion to reconsider), a copy of the opposition or a statement that there is no opposition to the writ, and the pertinent court minutes, if any. Counsel also failed to include the telephone numbers of the respondent judge and opposing counsel in the declaration. Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. See Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 2-18.7 & 4-9. In the event relator elects to file a new application with this Court, the application shall be filed on or before June 30, 2015. Any future filing on this issue should include the entire contents of this application, the missing items noted above, and a copy of this ruling.
