Higginbotham, J., dissents and would grant the writ application. In my view, the location of the sobriety checkpoint's advance warning signs did not adequately alert oncoming drivers that a checkpoint was ahead and I find it problematic that France Street, the street that relator could have safely turned onto before reaching the entrance to the checkpoint, was blocked off. Therefore, in my opinion, the checkpoint in this case did not meet the standards set forth in **State v. Jackson**, 2000-0015 (La. 7/6/00), 764 So.2d 64.
