**Pettigrew**, **J**., would not consider the writ application. Relator failed to comply with Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rule 4-2 and 4-5(C)(11), as she failed to file a request for a return date within thirty days of the ruling and failed to provide this Court with a copy of the return date. Relator also failed to comply with Rule 4-5(A) as she did not include a proper affidavit verifying the allegations of the petition and service to the trial court. Relator also violated Rules 4-5(B), 4-5(C)(1), (2), (3), (4), (5), and (8), as the application pages were not properly numbered, she failed to include an index, a jurisdictional statement, a statement of the case, issues and questions of law, assignments of error, and a copy of the pleadings upon which the ruling was founded, in particular the charging document.
