WRIT GRANTED. There is no evidence reflecting that relator tested positive for any illegal or prescribed drugs on November 7, 2014. Accordingly, the decision to revoke relator's probation because he had prescriptions filled without the court's approval is an abuse of the court's discretion. Accordingly, the order revoking relator's probation is reversed, and this case is remanded to the district court and the court is ordered to reinstate relator's probation and include any conditions the court feels are necessary.
