WRIT DENIED. If relator desires a free copy of his trial transcript, he must identify specific constitutional errors in the proceedings leading to his conviction and sentence, as required by La. Code Crim. P. art. 930.3. He must also specify with reasonable particularity the factual basis for such relief, and thereby meet the initial requirements set forth in La. Code Crim. P. art. 926 for filing an application for postconviction relief. Relator cannot make a showing of particularized need absent a properly filed application for postconviction relief, which sets out specific claims of constitutional errors requiring the requested documentation for support. State ex rel. Bernard v. Criminal District Court Section "J", 94-2247 (La. 4/28/95), 653 So.2d 1174, 1175 (per curiam).
