WRIT DENIED. A trial court has wide discretion in revoking a defendant's probation and this decision will not be reversed absent an abuse of discretion. See La. Code Crim. P. art. 900; **State ex rel. Robertson v. Maggio**, 341 So.2d 366, 369-70 (La. 1976). A "technical violation" means any violation except it shall not include being arrested, charged, or convicted of a felony, any intentional misdemeanor directly affecting the person, and, at the discretion of the court, any attempt to commit any intentional misdemeanor directly affecting the person. See La. Code Crim. P. art. 900(A)(6)(c)(i)(aa), (cc) & (dd).
