
**BEFORE: McDONALD, McCLENDON AND THERIOT, JJ.**

**WRIT NOT CONSIDERED.** Relator failed to comply with the return date requirements of Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 4-3 and 4-5(C)(11), by failing to timely file the writ application. The return date order required the application to be filed in this Court on or before October 15, 2015. This writ application, filed on October 16, 2015, appears to be untimely, and there is no documentation of a timely request for an extension of the original return date. Relator's affidavit does not appear to be properly notarized. The notary failed to include her notary identification number, or her Louisiana state bar roll number. See La. R.S. 35:12(A) & (B). Relator also failed to comply with the binding and page numbering requirements of Rule 4-5(B). Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. See Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 2-18.7 & 4-9. Because the trial in this case is scheduled for January 25, 2016, in the event relator elects to file a new application with this Court, the application shall be delivered to this Court on or before December 28, 2015, and the application should include documentation of an extension of the return date, correct the deficiencies herein, and comply with the requirements of Rule 4-4, concerning requests for expedited consideration. See also Rule 4-5(C)(12) & (D). Any future filing on this issue should include the entire contents of this application, the missing items noted above, and a copy of this ruling.
