

WRIT DENIED AS MOOT. On October 11, 2016, relator pled guilty to a single, amended charge of illegal carrying of a weapon, pursuant to **State v. Crosby**, 338 So.2d 584 (La. 1976). The state nol-prossed all of the remaining charged offenses. As a result of this plea, relator's pending writ application is moot. If relator wishes to seek review of the trial court's denial of his motion to suppress, he should do so by means of a properly filed appeal, as his **Crosby** plea reserved appellate review of this issue, not pretrial supervisory review.
