WRIT GRANTED. The trial court erred in determining that the witnesses at issue were not material witnesses. According to relator, the testimony of the witnesses was pertinent to his defense, as the witnesses would testify that Justin Knotts possessed the stolen vehicle and left it on their property. Thus, the court abused its discretion in denying the defense motion to issue subpoenas to out-of-state witnesses. The court's ruling is reversed and the trial court is ordered to grant relator's request for issuance of out-of-state subpoenas to these witnesses.

CHUTZ, J., dissents and would deny the writ. The trial court determined that the witnesses at issue were not material witnesses. Therefore, I find the court did not abuse its discretion in denying the defense motion to issue subpoenas to out-of-state witnesses. See La. Code Crim. P. art. 741.
