

WRIT GRANTED. The district court's ruling denying relator's application for postconviction relief is vacated and the case is remanded to the district court for the sole purpose of holding a hearing at which it will determine whether relator is entitled to an out-of-time appeal under the rule of **State v. Counterman**, 475 So.2d 336, 340 (La. 1985). The district court is ordered to appoint counsel to relator for the hearing.
