WRIT NOT CONSIDERED. All of the Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal relative to a document's content and format, except for provisions requiring binding, are applicable to documents that are E-Filed. See Local Rules, Rule 8(D). Counsel failed to comply with Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rule 4-5(A), by failing to include a Declaration verifying the allegations of the petition and service information with the addresses and telephone numbers of opposing counsel and the respondent judge, and he failed to include his electronic signature. Counsel also failed to comply with Rule 4-5(C)(2), (4), (5), (6), (8), (9) and (10), by failing to include a proper jurisdictional statement, the issues presented for review, assignments of error, a copy of the June 6, 2016 ruling at issue herein, the application for postconviction relief, a copy of the indictment, a statement that there is no opposition to the writ, and the pertinent court minutes. Although it is not a violation of the Uniform Rules, counsel failed to include a copy of the entire jury trial transcript. See City of Baton Rouge v. Plain, 433 So.2d 710 (La.), cert. denied, 464 U.S. 896, 104 S.Ct. 246, 78 L.Ed.2d 235 (1983). Accordingly, this Court cannot adequately review the district court's ruling herein. Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. See Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 2-18.7 & 4-9. In the event relator elects to file a new application with this Court, the application shall be filed on or before January 24, 2017. Any future filing on this issue should include the entire contents of this application, the missing items noted above, and a copy of this ruling.
