WRIT GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART. We grant the writ in part and vacate the portion of the May 12, 2017 judgment that addresses the treatment rendered to plaintiff. Louisiana Code of Civil Procedure article 966(F) provides that "(a) summary judgment may be rendered or affirmed only as to those issues set forth in the motion under consideration by the court at that time." The motion for partial summary judgment under review did not raise the issue of necessity or reasonableness of treatment rendered to plaintiff post-accident. Rather, it was limited to the issue of causation of plaintiff's injuries. Therefore, that portion of the May 12, 2017 judgment that addressed the reasonableness and necessity of treatment rendered to plaintiff is vacated. In all other respects, the writ is denied.
