

**WRIT DENIED.** The district court's judgment of September 18, 2017, dismissing relator's suit without prejudice is a final, appealable judgment. An appeal of this judgment can be taken by filing a motion for appeal, along with an order for the judge's signature showing the return date of the appeal, with the district court within the time delays set out in La. Code Civ. P. Art. 2087. Filing documents directly with this court does not suspend the running of the appeal delays. La. Code Civ. P. art. 2121. **Strickland v. Layrisson**, 96-1280 (La. App. 1st Cir. 6/20/97), 696 So.2d 621; writ denied, 97-1940 (La. 11/14/97), 704 So.2d 228.
