
In Re: Gregory Arrington, et al, applying for supervisory writs, 22nd Judicial District Court, Parish of St. Tammany, No. 2017-12010.

WRIT GRANTED WITH ORDER. The district court's September 12, 2017 judgment which granted the exception of prematurity filed by defendant, St. Tammany Parish Hospital Service District No. 1 d/b/a St. Tammany Parish Hospital, and dismissed it without prejudice is a final, appealable judgment. See La. Code Civ. P. art. 1915(A)(1). Thus, the writ application is granted for the limited purpose of remanding this matter to the district court with instructions to grant an appeal to plaintiffs, Gregory Arrington and Clarnetta Arrington, pursuant to the September 18, 2017 Notice of Intention to Apply for Writs of Review. See **In Re Howard**, 541 So.2d 195 (La. 1989) (per curiam). In the event plaintiffs, Gregory Arrington and Clarnetta Arrington, seek to appeal the district court's judgment, they shall submit a new order for appeal to the trial court within fifteen days of this court's order. Additionally, a copy of this court's order is to be included in the appellate record.
