Based upon the trial court having previously allowed the filing of a third party demand for which issue has not been joined, and the recent dismissal of two defendants in the action, the court finds that the trial court abused its discretion in failing to grant a continuance in this matter. Accordingly, the application is granted, the court's November 13, 2017 denial of relator's motion to continue is reversed, and the matter is remanded for further proceedings. However, the continuance shall be granted only if mover is responsible for all costs, including plaintiff's costs and court costs, necessitated by the continuance.
