

P. art. 930.6, hereafter, unless he can show that one of the narrow exceptions authorizing the filing of a successive application provided in La. Code Crim. P. art. 930.4 applies, relator has exhausted his right to postconviction relief. See **State ex rel. Tabor v. State**, 2015-0033 (La. 10/30/15), 178 So.3d 558 (per curiam); see also **State ex rel. Bonvillain v. State**, 2015-2331 (La. 3/14/16), 186 So.3d 644 (per curiam).
