

WRIT GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART. A copy of the judgment granting or denying relief and written or transcribed reasons for the judgment shall be furnished to the petitioner, the district attorney, and the custodian. La. Code Crim. P. art. 930.1. Relator's claim that he did not receive notice of the 2015 ruling dismissing his first application for postconviction relief appears to have merit. Accordingly, the writ application is granted for the sole purpose of allowing relator to seek review with this court of the denial of his first application for postconviction relief without the necessity of obtaining a return date. Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. See Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 2-18.7 & 4-9. In the event relator elects to file a new writ application with this court, the application shall be filed on or before February 15, 2018. Any future filing should include the entire contents of this application and should include any other portions of the district court record that might support the claims raised in the application for postconviction relief. In all other respects, the writ application is denied.
