WRIT DENIED. The records of the East Baton Rouge Parish Clerk of Court show that the motions at issue herein were correctly filed under case number 09-99-0476 on October 12, 2017, and on November 16, 2017, the district court denied the motions. Accordingly, relator's request for mandamus relief is moot. At the time relator's probation was revoked, he had not fulfilled the original period of time that he was required to register as a sex offender nor had the obligation been extinguished by operation of law. Therefore, he was required to comply with the requirements contained in La. R.S. 15:544. See 2007 La. Acts No. 460, § 6. Thus, the district court did not err by denying "Motion to Terminate State of Louisiana Sex Offender Registry Requirements" or the "Motion for Permanent Injunction and Restraining Order." See La. R.S. 15:544(D)(1). See also La. R.S. 15:544(E).
