
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**BEFORE: HIGGINBOTHAM, HOLDRIDGE AND PENZATO, JJ.**

**WRIT NOT CONSIDERED.** The writ application fails to comply with Rule 4-5(C)(8) of the Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal. Relator, Frank Raborn, did not include a copy of the exhibits to Defendants The Neuromedical Center, APMC and Jeffrey Albea, M.D.'s Motion for Partial Summary Judgment nor did Relator include a copy of their reply memorandum. In order for this court to examine the district court's ruling, it must be presented with all pleadings on which the judgment was founded. The writ application also fails to comply with Rule 4-5(A), which requires that the applicant attach "an affidavit verifying the allegations of the application and certifying that a copy has been delivered or mailed to the respondent judge and to opposing counsel, and to any opposing party not represented by counsel." While Relator did include an affidavit, it was non-compliant. Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 2-18.7 & 4-9. In the event Relator seeks to file a new application with this court, it must contain all pertinent documentation and must comply with Rule 2-12.2 of the Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal. Any new application must be filed on or before April 20, 2018, and must contain a copy of this ruling.
