
In Re: Texas Brine Company, LLC, applying for supervisory writs, 23rd Judicial District Court, Parish of Assumption, No. 34202.

WRIT GRANTED WITH ORDER. The trial court's September 27, 2017 judgments, which granted defendants' motions for partial summary judgments regarding Texas Brine Company's breach of contract claims, are designated as final and appealable judgments. See La. Code Civ. P. art. 1915(B)(1). Therefore, the writ is granted for the limited purpose of remanding the case to the district court with instructions to grant relator, Texas Brine Company, LLC, an appeal pursuant to the pleading that notified the district court of Texas Brine's intention to seek writs. See **In re Howard**, 541 So.2d 195, 197 (La. 1989) (*per curiam*). Additionally, a copy of this Court's order is to be included in the appellate record.
