

**REHEARING DENIED.** The delay for applying for a new trial commences to run on the day after the clerk has mailed, or the sheriff has served, the notice of judgment as required by Article 1913. La. Code Civ. P. art. 1974. Notice of the signing of a final judgment shall be mailed by the clerk of court to each party not represented by counsel. La. Code. Civ. P. art. 1913. The final judgment at issue in this case is not one for which service by a sheriff is contemplated under Article 1913. Accordingly, notice of judgment in this case was sent on November 9, 2017 and the deadline for filing (or submitting to prison authorities) a motion for new trial was November 20, 2017.
