The motion for new trial/rehearing filed by relators does not serve to extend the delays for filing writs from the interlocutory ruling denying relators' "Motion for Physical Examination of Plaintiff, Motion for Examination of Radiographic Images by Neuroradiologist, and Motion for Extension of Discovery Deadline Dates." See **Allstate Ins. Co. v. Mohamadian**, 2009-1126 (La. App. 1st Cir. 2/17/10), 35 So.3d 1118, 1121. Accordingly, the instant writ application is denied as untimely.
