WRIT GRANTED WITH ORDER. The district court's January 30, 2018 judgment, as amended by the district court's April 5, 2018 order, maintaining the defendant's, Louisiana State Police Crime Lab, Exception of Prescription; dismissing with prejudice all claims for damages against defendant, Louisiana State Police Crime Lab; and dismissing without prejudice all other claims related to declaratory, mandamus, or injunctive relief against the defendant, Louisiana State Police Crime Lab, is a final, appealable judgment pursuant to Louisiana Code of Civil Procedure article 1915(A)(1). Therefore, the writ is granted for the limited purpose of remanding the case to the district court with instructions to grant plaintiff, Joel G. Porter, an appeal pursuant to the pleading that notified the district court of plaintiff's intention to seek writs. See In re Howard, 541 So.2d 195, 197 (La. 1989) (per curiam). Additionally, a copy of this court's order is to be included in the appellate record.
