The trial court's April 13, 2018 judgment granting the peremptory exception of no right of action filed by defendants Lamar Advertising of Louisiana, LLC and TLC Properties, Inc. is a final, appealable judgment. Therefore, the writ application is granted for the limited purpose of remanding the case to the trial court with instructions to grant relator, Poule D'Eau Properties, LLC, an appeal pursuant to the pleading that notified the district court of Poule D'Eau's intention to seek supervisory writs.
