

WRIT GRANTED. The record shows that at the September 12, 2012, revocation proceedings, the clerk incorrectly informed the district court of the sentences that were originally imposed on November 9, 2011, and incorrectly stated the manner in which the sentences were ordered to be served with one another. Accordingly, the ruling on the motion to clarify and correct sentences is reversed, the writ application is granted, and this matter is remanded to the lower court for resentencing in compliance with the terms of the original sentence and the mandates of La. Code Crim. P. art. 883.
