

WRIT GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART. Based upon the testimony adduced at the bench trial, the evidence was insufficient to support the conviction for hit and run but the evidence is sufficient to support the responsive offense of failure to report an accident. Therefore, relator's conviction for hit and run is reversed, the sentence is vacated, and this matter is remanded for entry of judgment of conviction for failure to report an accident, and sentencing thereon. Relator's contention that the prohibition against double jeopardy was violated when he was convicted of hit and run and failure to report an accident is moot. In all other respects, relator's writ application is denied.
