

PETITION FOR MANDAMUS DENIED. While the 19th Judicial District Court appears to have subject matter jurisdiction over this judicial review, La. R.S. 15:1177, this court has no original jurisdiction to hear and decide the matter. Further, appellate courts generally will not consider issues raised for the first time on appeal. **Thomas v. Bridges**, 2013-1855, (La. 5/7/14), 144 So.3d 1001, 1009. Accordingly, we deny the petition for mandamus. Because judicial review apparently has not been sought in the 19th Judicial District Court, this court has nothing to review.
