

WRIT DENIED. We note that the trial court's May 23, 2018 judgment lacks the requisite decretal language to constitute a final appealable judgment. See La. Code Civ. P. art. 1918; **Standard Ins. Co. v. Spottsville**, 2016-0020 (La. App. 1st Cir. 9/16/16), 204 So.3d 253. Once the judgment is amended to include proper decretal language, the judgment may constitute a final judgment or a partial judgment under La. Code Civ. P. art. 1915(B). Accordingly, this court declines to exercise its supervisory jurisdiction.
