Therefore, the notice of intent, filed on January 22, 2019, was untimely. Additionally, the writ application does not contain a copy of the plaintiffs' supplemental and amended memoranda in opposition to the motion for summary judgment or a copy of the pertinent court minutes in violation of Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 4-5(C)(9) and (10).
