I find the plaintiff, Asset Integrity Management Solutions, L.L.C., has failed to state a claim against G.E.C., Inc., nor does it have a right of action against G.E.C., Inc., because Asset Integrity Management Solutions, L.L.C., a third party, has no contractual privity with G.E.C., Inc. Further, merely because G.E.C., Inc. could potentially cause economic harm to Asset Integrity Management Solutions, LLC is insufficient to create a duty giving rise to tort liability.
