

Gedric**, 99-1213 (La. App. 1st Cir. 6/3/99), 741 So.2d 849, 852 (per curiam), writ denied, 99-1830 (La. 11/5/99), 751 So.2d 239. Relator's motion was untimely. See La. Code Crim. P. art. 881.1(A)(1).
