

WRIT DENIED. The **Boykin** transcript shows that a factual basis was established on the record for the home invasion charge and that relator was advised of and voluntarily and intelligently waived his triad of constitutional rights. Therefore, relator failed to establish his ineffective assistance of counsel claims or that he is entitled to postconviction relief. See La. Code Crim. P. art. 930.2. See also **State ex rel. Roper v. Cain**, 99-2173 (La. App. 1st Cir. 10/26/99), 763 So.2d 1, 5 (*per curiam*), writ denied, 2000-0975 (La. 11/17/00), 773 So.2d 733. Accordingly, the district court did not err by denying the application for postconviction relief.
