

WRIT NOT CONSIDERED. The State failed to comply with Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rule 4-3 by failing to include documentation of a timely request for an extension to the return date. The State also failed to comply with Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rule 4-5(C)(8) and (10), by failing to include a copy of the pleadings upon which the ruling was founded (a copy of the bill of information) and the pertinent court minutes, if any. Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. See Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 2-18.7 & 4-9. Any future filing on this issue should include the entire contents of this application, the missing items noted above, and a copy of this ruling. If relator elects to file a new application in compliance with Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rule 4-5, which includes proof that a timely extension to the return date was obtained, he may do so on or before July 17, 2019. However, a copy of the original return date, any requests for extensions to the return date, and any extensions set by the district court shall be included.
