Code Crim. P. art. 703(E)(1). The district court must hold an evidentiary hearing when a defendant alleges facts that would require granting relief. See **State v. Wilson**, 2016-0912 (La. App. 1st Cir. 2/22/17), 2017 WL 716085, writ denied, 2017-0392 (La. 11/13/17), 229 So.3d 924.
