If counsel does not wish to adopt relator's motions, the district court is instructed to evaluate the motions disruptive potential in light of **State v. Melon**, 95-2209 (La. 9/22/95), 660 So.2d 466 before determining whether to conduct a hearing consistent with **State v. Alexander**, 2007-1236 (La. App. 3d Cir. 4/9/08), 980 So.2d 877. See **State v. Thibodeaux**, 2017-0705 (La. 12/6/17), 236 So.3d 1253, 1256.
