Trebilcock, J., concurs but would further state that while defendant correctly notes that the trial court erroneously concluded that Officer Martin did not collect evidence at the scene, such error is harmless. *People v Williams*, 483 Mich 226, 243; 769 NW2d 605 (2009). Officer Martin did not testify at defendant's trial, the evidence collected by Officer Martin was unconnected to defendant, and defendant did not connect Officer Martin's other unrelated bad acts to this case.
