O R D E R

The Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility has filed a petition for disciplinary action alleging that respondent Elizabeth Megan Carroll Trimble committed professional misconduct, namely, neglect of a client matter, failure to appear in court, failure to communicate with a client, misappropriation of advance expenses, and failure to cooperate with a disciplinary investigation, in violation of Minn. R. Prof. Conduct 1.3, 1.4, 1.16(d), 3.2, 3.4(c), 8.1(b), 8.4(c) and (d), and Rule 25, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR). Respondent did not respond to the petition.

On April 10, 2012, the Director moved for summary relief pursuant to Rule 13(b), RLPR. On May 3, 2012, this court issued an order deeming the allegations in the petition admitted. *See* Rule 13(b), RLPR. The parties were invited to submit briefs on the
