ORDER

The Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility filed a petition for disciplinary action alleging that respondent Rachel Lauren Toberman has committed professional misconduct warranting public discipline, namely, engaging in a conflict of interest, making false statements to and failing to communicate with clients, failing to return a client file, failing to cooperate with a disciplinary investigation, and making false statements in the course of a disciplinary investigation, in violation of Minn. R. Prof. Conduct 1.4(a)(3) and (4), 1.7(a)(1) and (2), 1.16(d), 4.1, 7.1, 8.1(a), 8.4(c), and Rule 25, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RPLR).

Respondent waives her procedural rights under Rule 14, RLPR, unconditionally admits the allegations in the petition, and with the Director, recommends that the appropriate discipline is an indefinite suspension of no less than nine months, with the right to apply for reinstatement after six months.

The court has independently reviewed the file and approves the recommended disposition.
