## **ORDER**

By order of this Court issued March 22, 2001, Rule 4.02 of the Uniform Rules of Circuit and County Court Practice was amended to require, in addition to the Seventy-five Dollar deposit required in all cases, a deposit of One Thousand Dollars for cases in which a complaint is filed pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 11-27-81. Since the entry of the Court's order, suggestions have been made that such requirement may create difficulties which have not been anticipated. The Court, en banc, thus finds it proper that the effect of such amendment be suspended pending further study by the Court.
