MASTER'S REPORT

The claim in this case is owned by Hooker Cattle Co. and appeared in the Preliminary Decree for Basin 40D with an issue remark and received an Objection from USA Bureau of Land Management.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On January 24, 2024, the Parties submitted a Stipulation ("Stipulation").
- 2. Claim 40D 179396-00 is a water spreading irrigation claim from an unnamed tributary of Big Dry Creek. The parties agree that the legal land description of the place of use needs further refinement.
 - 3. The place of use for Claim 40D 179396-00 should be clarified as follows:

4. Claim 40D 179396-00 also has an issue remark which states the location of the dike cannot be identified from available data. The Stipulation and attached aerial photographs show the dike in the NENWSE Sec. 2, as decreed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that an element of the prima facie claim is incorrect. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.
- 2. The degree or weight of evidence needed to contradict or overcome the prima facie proof statute is a preponderance of the evidence. *Burkhartsmeyer et al. v. Burkhartsmeyer et al.*, Case 40G-2, (MT Water Court Memorandum Opinion and Order Adopting Master's Report, Mar. 11, 1997). The Montana Supreme Court has defined preponderance as "a relatively modest standard that the statutory criteria are 'more

probable than not' to have been met." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203 ¶ 33, 357 Mont. 438, 240 P.3d 628.

- 3. The Montana Water Court is permitted to use information submitted by the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation, the statement of claim, information from approved compacts, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate water right claims. Section 85-2-231(2), MCA.
- 4. When resolving issue remarks, the Montana Water Court must weigh the information resulting in the issue remark and the issue remark against the claimed water right. Section 85-2-247(2), MCA.
- 5. The evidence entered into the record is sufficient to make the changes to the claim's place of use and resolve the issue remark.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, this Master recommends the Court make the changes specified above to correct the Preliminary Decree for this Basin.

A Post Decree Abstract of Water Right Claim is served with this Report to confirm the recommended corrections have been made in the state's centralized record system.
