MEMORANDUM OPINION

20 **VANZI, Chief Judge.**

1 Following a guilty plea to aggravated driving while under the influence of **{1}** intoxicating liquor or drugs (DWI), contrary to NMSA 1978, § 66-8-102(D)(1) 2 (2016), and driving the wrong way (one-way roadway), contrary to NMSA 1978, 3 § 66-7-316 (2003), [DS 2; RP 56] Defendant appealed from the judgment and 4 sentence, arguing that one of the prior DWIs used for enhancement to a fourth DWI 5 was invalid because the State did not establish that he was represented by counsel. We 6 7 issued a first notice of proposed summary disposition proposing to affirm. In response, Defendant filed a memorandum in opposition. Upon consideration of Defendant's 8 arguments, we issued a second notice of proposed summary disposition proposing to 9 reverse. The State has filed a timely response indicating that it will not be filing a 10 11 memorandum in opposition. Accordingly, for the reasons set forth in our second 12 notice of proposed summary disposition, we reverse.
