11) Defendant appeals from the district court's final judgment granting Plaintiff's motions for summary judgment on Defendant's counterclaims for harassment, retaliation, and defamation. We issued a notice of proposed summary disposition, proposing to affirm. Plaintiff filed a memorandum in support of our notice. Defendant, however, has not filed a response to our notice, and the time for doing so has expired.
