DISPOSITIONAL ORDER OF REVERSAL

WHEREAS, this matter having come before the Court upon our grant, pursuant to Rule 12-501 NMRA, of Petitioner Peter Mendoza's petition for writ of

certiorari seeking review of the district court's denial of his petition for writ of habeas corpus; and

- The Court having considered the briefs and being otherwise fully informed on the issues and applicable law; and
